



Fan Information:

Alcohol:

You must be 21 to purchase, possess or consume all alcohol products on the Wilmot Raceway premises. No alcohol can be brought into the Wilmot Raceway property.

ATM:

For your convenience, there is an ATM machine located at the Main Ticket Booth.

ATV/Golf Carts/Other Motorized Vehicles:

These vehicles are only allowed in the Pit area of the track and must be insured by the racing teams and be utilized only for racing related activities. They are not allowed out of the pit area.

Cameras & Video Equipment:

Guests are welcome to bring cameras and video recorders into the Speedway for *personal* use. Cameras and video recorders must not exceed 14" x 14" x 14". Guests should not obstruct the views of others while taking pictures. Tripods, monopods and other camera support devices are not permitted. Live video recording and posting of races to social media is not permitted. Wilmot Raceway reserves the right to remove any Guests who do not cooperate with this policy.

Camping:

There is a campground at Wilmot Raceway for any campers. No campers can park outside of a camping spot.

Cash/Checks/Credit Cards:

Cash and credit/debit cards will be accepted at the Wilmot Raceway.

Coolers:

Coolers are not permitted past the track gates. No carry-ins are allowed.

Concessions:

Wilmot Raceway offers full concession stands on both sides of the racetrack offering items such as hot dogs, brats, hamburgers, cheeseburgers, chips, popcorn, nachos, soft pretzels, candy, hot and cold beverages.

Wilmot Raceway also sells Miller Products. We are proud to have the Wilmot Fire Department Association sell the beer for the Raceway. Beer is not sold on the Pit side of the track.

Dogs:

Wilmot Raceway welcomes Seeing Eye Dogs or other animal assistance utilized by the disabled or visually impaired. Proper documentation is required for these animals prior to entry. All other animals are prohibited inside the track gates.

Fires:

No fires are permitted on the property except for at the designated fire pit in the campground.

Lost and Found:

Is located at the Main Ticket Booth.

Parking:

There is no charge for parking at the Wilmot Raceway. Handicapped spaces are available near the Main Gate.

Pit Passes:

Pit passes are available. Those under 18 years must have both parents or guardians sign the waiver form. For more information, see **Waivers**.

Membership Passes:

This membership is for Wilmot Raceway Drivers specifically and cannot be combined with any other membership for listed discount on admission. This membership is mandatory for anyone that is wanting to run for points NO MATTER THE DIVISION YOU ARE FROM. They will receive \$6 off of pit admission with valid membership card. If you want to sit for points, you must purchase the membership by the end of the 2nd night of your division racing otherwise your membership will strictly only give you a discounted admission. To receive payouts from the membership, you must

either be present yourself at the banquet or send a representative to the banquet.

Grandstand Season Passes:

These passes are non-refundable and can be only used once per event listed. Please note this pass is not able to be used for leased events at our track (Monster Truck Throwdown, World of Outlaws, DAS Fest, etc.. Please also note this pass does not include the required admission to the Kenosha County Fair for the events. If the pass holder chooses to go to the pits for the day, the passholder would only need to pay the upcharge from general admission to pit admission when presented (i.e. general admission is \$15 and pit admission is \$25 for said event, the pass holder would pay the up charge on the day of for \$10 to access the pits during the race).

Race Day Schedule:

Schedule Varies. See specific date on tickets page of website for specifics.

Rain Out Policy:

Once all heat races are completed, it is considered an official race. If rain comes prior to the heat races being completed and the races cannot continue, race fans can use their receipt to return to another race. If there is a difference in pricing on the night they return, they would be required to pay the difference. There will be no refund if the race night price is lower than the price the fan paid.

Re-Entry Policy:

Fans are allowed to leave the Grandstand area. A handstamp will be required for re-entry.

Reserved Seats:

The only races with reserved seating will be the World of Outlaw race. Reserved tickets for that race are available at www.slspromotions.com

Restrooms:

Restrooms are located on the Grandstand side of the Raceway. These are open and available for use when the Raceway is open. There are also porta-potties scattered around the property for use anytime.

Severe Weather:

If severe weather strikes during a Wilmot Raceway event, here is some important information. Wilmot Raceway does not provide adequate protection from extremely high winds, tornadoes or lightning. Personal protection is everyone's responsibility. Be proactive and know your plan should severe weather strike. Plan in advance what you, your family and friends will do if severe weather approaches. Monitor the weather closely and take necessary precautions to ensure your safety. The American Red Cross recommends that if you are caught outdoors and cannot quickly access a shelter, it is best to get into a vehicle and buckle your seat belt until you are able to get to the closest shelter. Wilmot Raceway will provide information on weather related events through the public address system.

Smoking:

The Wilmot Raceway adheres to the Wisconsin state law regarding smoking safety: please take note of all posted signs that there is NO SMOKING allowed within the Raceway except in designated areas. The designated area for smoking is clearly marked and has disposal containers for the disposal of used smoking materials. In addition, included in this restriction are Vapor units and Vaping. As we have many young people and children as guests, please adhere to this policy while visiting so everyone can enjoy a safe and fun atmosphere. Wisconsin state law prohibits smoking in the Grandstands.

Waivers:

Parents MUST sign a parental minor release waiver for any child under 18. Only parents or legal guardians are allowed to sign for a minor. Both natural parents are required to sign for any minor (under 18) competitor or spectator.
